- Have earned a High School Diploma or GED.
- Able to obtain a North Carolina Driver's License.
- Be a U. S. Citizen with no felony convictions.
- Honorable Discharge
- Pass an extensive background investigation which includes (polygraph examination, psychological screening, medical exam, and drug test.)
