All Citadel students are encouraged to begin their Career Exploration as they begin their academic studies at The Citadel. It is never too early to begin researching your career options. The sooner you begin, the better prepared you will be to make informed decisions regarding your career.

- ▶ Employers post full-time positions, seasonal jobs, part-time jobs, and internship opportunities with our office through *The Gate* (our online job board and resume database), as well as on their own organization websites. Employers will also review *The Gate* for resumes before or instead of posting positions.
- ▶ Take advantage of the opportunities that employers post directly with our office (on *The Gate*), but recognize the need to activate an independent job search as well. Other resources of the Career Center are designed to help you with this effort, including a step-by-step outline of the **Job Search Process** for **full-time, seasonal, and internship** searches. Resources for those **transitioning from the military** are also outlined within the Job Search Process.
- ▶ **Seeking employment in Education?** Review the resources, including links to various School Districts and Departments of Education by State.
- ▶ **Considering a graduate program of study?** Resources to help you with your search are available, as well as for job searching during/after earning your advanced degree.
- ▶ Current **MBA** candidates and those considering an MBA may wish to review a variety of resources specific to your needs.
