

In recognition of his scientific career, Dr. Louis DuBose Quin, B.S.Chemistry, class of 1947, has been named Honorary Editor of the international chemical journal *Heteroatom Chemistry* published by John Wiley and Sons, Inc. Dr. Quin has written about 250 research papers in this field, and has authored or co-edited seven books, with an eighth in press. Dr. Quin was a James B. Duke Professor and Chairman of Chemistry at Duke University, and Professor and Head of Chemistry at the University of Massachusetts-Amherst. After retirement, he was Distinguished Visiting Professor of Chemistry at the University of North Carolina-Wilmington, and presently is Adjunct Professor there.

Additional recent information: Quin was the first recipient (1997) of the international Arbusovs Medal for research in the organic chemistry of the element phosphorus, which was instituted by the Russian Academy of Sciences, and is included in “*2000 Outstanding Scientists of the 20th Century*” published by the International Biographical Centre, Cambridge, England. He also was North Carolina Distinguished Lecturer in Chemistry in 1999, and has been named a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science.
