

## Office of the Registrar **Grade Replacement Form**

Undergraduate Students

- 1. Undergraduate student may choose to repeat a course in which they earned a grade of "C" or below.
- 2. A student may not repeat a course which is taught at a lower level than or serves as a prerequisite for a course which the student has already completed.
- 3. The original course grade(s) will be replaced by the most recent grade when calculating a student's GPA, quality hours and earned credit hours.
- 4. Both the old and new grades will appear on the student's transcript, but only the newer grade will be used in calculating the student's GPA.
- 5. Grade Replacement will be allowed on a **maximum of 16 credit hours** over the course of a student's undergraduate career.
- 6. Credits from other institution can not be used as grade replacement.
